1. Job Title: Associate Professor (retirement age: 65)
2. Affiliation: Department of Earth and Planetary Sciences, School of Science
3. Academic Field: Earth and Planetary Material Sciences, especially based on Geology, Petrology, and Mineralogy
4. Qualification Requirements:
 - (1) Applicants are required to have a doctoral degree or Ph.D. in the research fields above.
 - (2) Applicants should have an original research concept to promote their own research. In addition, they should be highly interested in conducting interdisciplinary study in collaboration with various research fields in the department and related research institutes.
 - (3) Applicants should have the ability to supervise and teach graduate and undergraduate students.
 - (4) Applicants are required to share responsibility for administrative work.
5. Position Start Date: April 1st, 2018, or earliest date thereafter
6. Salary: It will be determined according to the National University Corporation Tokyo Institute of Technology Salary Regulations for Employees, with annual or monthly salary, which will be determined before starting the position.
7. Application Materials: Send following seven data in the form of PDF file.
 - (1) Curriculum Vitae
 - (2) Description of achievement in research and education (1 page limit)
 - (3) Plan of future research and education (1 page limit)
 - (4) List of publications:
 - (A) Papers published in refereed international journals
 - (B) Other remarkable works
 - (5) Reprints of five important papers
 - (6) List of research funds acquired by the applicant
 - (7) Names of four references (two of them should be in the applicant's present country, and the others should be outside the country); name, affiliation, and e-mail address

Note: In the selection process, applicants may be required to submit some additional materials.
